The meeting should involve a Senior Manager, School Meals Supervisory Assistants, Kitchen Assistants and School Cook (Important for Dining Centres also). For schools that are B&NES Catered a representative from the Catering service should also attend along with Claire Riggs (Food in Schools) and/or Judy Allies for schools enrolled in the Director of Public Health Award.
