



Top Tips for Road Safety

When going out and about please remind children:



- What a road is.
- What traffic is.
- That traffic exists in many forms.
- That traffic can be dangerous.



- They must always use a car seat.



- They should always walk on the side of the pavement away from the traffic.
- They should always hold an adult's hand when near traffic and when crossing roads.



- They should never cross a road on their own.
- What stop, look and listen means.



- That it is important for other road users to be able to see them.
- Bright or fluorescent clothing (in daytime) and reflective clothing (at night) will help to keep them safe.
