

Scenario Activity

30 mins

KS 2

An activity in which children consider how they might respond to children facing different challenges. They consider the impact of different responses on the person in the scenario and also the impact on themselves.

What you need

Scenario examples with photos.

Large sheets of paper and pens, if class are to create their own characters

Method

- Class are divided into small groups of 6/7
- Select a scenario and give copies of the same scenario to each group.
- Ask someone from each group to read the scenario to their group.
- Draw their attention to the information and questions on the back of the scenario.
- After a brief discussion of some of the ways they might respond to the character in their scenario the groups are asked to role-play a response to the character in this scenario. If they wish they may want to try a couple of different responses.
- Encourage different people to take the character role in each role play and suggest those not involved in the role play should watch carefully and think about how this response affects everyone involved
